By joining the B.R.F.F.A., you can benefit from some of the following:

Club Competitions; sponsored by Orvis, Snowbee and Bristol Water plc., these are a great way to meet like-minded anglers with that desire to hone their competition techniques. (We usually hold both boat and bank sections at these events.)

Annual Auction; each year members may take along unwanted Christmas gifts or tackle that has become surplus to the owner's use and earn both the club and the member some cash.

Quiz night; we are in our third year of this popular event, and hope to take it forward each year.

Public liability insurance; through club membership anglers will be covered by up to 2 million pounds in the event of accident.
